**OTTAWA (June 23, 2014, at 8)** – The second annual <u>Welcoming Ottawa Week (WOW)</u> will be celebrated in Ottawa between June 23 to 28, 2014 at various venues in the city, in the run up to Canada Day on July 1st. The celebration this year will build on the overwhelming success of the inaugural WOW in 2013, when Ottawa Mayor, Jim Watson officially proclaimed the last week each year of June as Welcoming Ottawa Week.

The <u>2014 WOW Calendar of Events</u> features thirty five diverse events catering to all tastes and designed to express Ottawa's welcoming spirit to immigrants and to promote quality interactions between Ottawa residents, old and new.
