We are so proud of what we accomplish every year despite funding cuts. Here is a brief summary of how the OCCSC helps newcomers successfully integrate into our Ottawa community last year:

- 1,559 newcomers were served and 1387 first time to use our services
- 432 group activities at various Ottawa Resource Centre locations.
- 639 children were cared for through our child-minding services.
- 898 new clients received assistance from In-TAC - our Employment Services Division
- 156 gained employment and/or professional job placements.
- 196 hiring partners and over 300 small and medium-sized businesses supported In-TAC initiatives.
- 898 clients received language support through our 16 Language Training classes.
- 210 volunteers contributed 8,290 hours of much appreciated assistance to the community.

The programs supported by the funds raised through the Gala and other OCCSC events are directed towards helping new immigrants integrate economically and socially into Canadian society -- to offer new members in our community, hope, optimism ... and a sense of opportunity. With continuing government funding cut-backs your support is now even more important than ever!
